- Matt- seems that the funding gap will be just to maintain the status quo will be a feat.
- Unincorporated areas – approx. \$360 Million Gap of road condition PCI (Pavement Condition Index)
- \$120 Million SacRT Funding Gap – to maintain current service (NOT including improvements of complete streets or 1st and last mile)
- Falls back on state of repair (SB1 only closes a small amount of the GAPS)
- Consultant – Townsend : Also concerned and acknowledges that voters must see their needs in the projects.
- **GHG goals will not be met if closing the funding gap is the only goal.**
